## COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

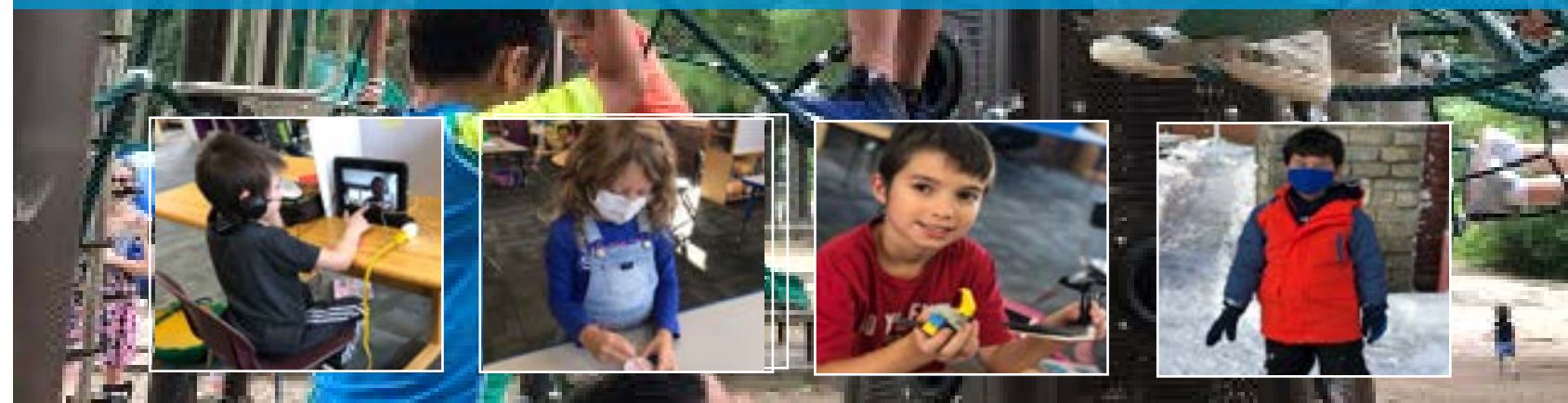
Safety is the number one priority of The John M Barry Boys & Girls Club of Newton, and we continue to do everything possible to keep children, our staff, and volunteers protected from the COVID-19 virus. We follow EEC and CDC guidelines and regulations including limitations on group size, vehicular transport, and activities.

Every day parents complete an online health attestation form before arriving to the Boys & Girls Club. Upon arrival a licensed child care staff member takes the child's temperature while wearing PPE. The child(ren) are then escorted into the building to join their consistent cohort of children and staff. Handwashing is completed multiple times every day. The physical program space is designed to promote social distancing and masks are required of children anytime 6 feet of distance can't be maintained. Children and staff who have been in contact with a COVID-19 positive individual and those with a temperature of greater than 100 degrees may not attend the program. The program follows the current guidelines for exclusions set forth by Early Education and Care (EEC).

During Summer 2020 we provided 9 weeks of high quality childcare under full covid-19 precautions. We also upgraded the WIFI throughout our facility to the level required to facilitate online learning for students.

We are pleased to be able to offer remote learning at the Club and to provide a full day of activities to engage your child during out-of-School time while always putting the HEALTH and SAFETY of the children and staff first.

## Flexible Registration Options

With the varied school schedules families can have this school year we are offering 3 or 5 day registration options for families.

Depending on when your child starts or ends their school day we will be here for them. With drop off times of 8 am, 12:45 pm, or 2:15 pm we are here to support your family.

## Staff

The Club enjoys the year round support of a team of highly motivated youth professionals who are First Aid and CPR certified. We explore the activities that we enjoy most in our daily lives are constantly researching new ideas and techniques. All staff undergo rigorous background checks, drug testing, and hours of training to prepare for the season.

Staff to child ratios follow EEC regulations for a maximum staff to child ratio of 1:13. Due to the flexible scheduling options, this ratio is frequently lower.

## Mission

The John M. Barry Boys & Girls Club of Newton's mission is to inspire and enable young people to reach their full potential as productive, caring, and responsible citizens.

The Club, incorporated in 1954, strives to help our members, ages 6-18, develop self-esteem, educational and social competencies, a sense of wellbeing with a moral compass all facilitated through the Club's caring professional adult staff providing guidance and activities that meet the unique interests/needs of elementary, middle, and high school youth.



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- All Transportation is parent provided (Including on in-person school days)
- 3 Day Options are available with reduced pricing
- Children will be assigned to groups by grade and multiple grades may be in a group.
- Grades K-8 will be participating in a licensed child care program
- Drop off times are staggered, program day ends 9 hours after start
- While we will guide your child towards their online learning activities, they are responsible for maintaining their own schedules and completing assignments. The Club in no way guarantees academic performance for participants in the program.

A DEPOSIT OF 1 WEEK IS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION. FEES WILL BE PRO-RATED IF NEWTON SWITCHES TO FULL IN PERSON SCHOOL IN THE MIDDLE OF A MONTH. NO REFUNDS FOR CANCELLED OR CHANGED REGISTRATIONS.
